The total number of Shares entitling the Shareholders to attend and vote on all the proposed resolutions at the AGM was 878,418,000 Shares, which represents the total number of issued Shares as at the date of the AGM. There were no (i) treasury shares held by the Company (including any treasury shares held or deposited with the Central Clearing and Settlement System established and operated by Hong Kong Securities Clearing Company Limited) and as such no voting rights of treasury shares have been exercised at the AGM; and (ii) repurchased shares which are pending cancellation and should therefore be excluded from the total number of issued Shares for the purpose of the AGM.

To the best of the Directors' knowledge, information and belief having made all reasonable enquiries, there was no Share entitling the Shareholders to attend and abstain from voting in favour of any of the resolutions at the AGM as set out in Rule 13.40 of the Listing Rules and no Shareholder was required to abstain from voting on any of the resolutions at the AGM under the Listing Rules. There were no restrictions on any Shareholders to cast votes on any of the resolutions at the AGM. None of the Shareholders had indicated their intention in the Circular to vote against or to abstain from voting on any of the resolutions at the AGM.

Shareholders or their proxies holding 399,732,356 Shares with voting rights, representing approximately 45.51% of the total number of Shares entitling the Shareholders to attend and vote, were present and constituted a quorum of the AGM in accordance with the Articles.

Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited, the share registrar and transfer office of the Company in Hong Kong, was appointed as the scrutineer at the AGM for the purpose of vote-taking.

All the Directors, namely Mr. Liu Yang, Mr. Chen Xiaohua, Mr. Dou Aobo, Mr. Wang Zijiang, Mr. Leung Kam Wan, Mr. Liu Chenguang and Ms. Shan Honghong, attended the AGM in person or through an electronic facility.
